Res. #2011/54 – McMorris/Morrison

That the minutes of the regular council meeting of March 1, 2011 be accepted, as circulated.

Res #2011/55 – McMorris/Morrison

Whereas Sunset Boulevard is a municipal road owned by the Province;

And Whereas the Rural Municipality of Victoria Beach has the direction, control and management of municipal roads within its boundaries;

And Whereas the Province of Manitoba proposes to authorize the placement of temporary super sandbags on Sunset Boulevard that may remain for two or three years for shoreline erosion protection while longterm measures are considered:

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That Council supports the Province of Manitoba in principle authorizing the proposed work on Sunset Boulevard and will not object as long as the measures do not materially and significantly affect the ability of the public to walk along Sunset Boulevard.

<u>Delegation – Mark Tooley – Shoreline Protection King Edward / Alexandra</u>

Mr. Tooley was present to discuss the King Edward/Alexandra "group's" sandbag proposal. Highlights of the discussion included:

- Sandbags would be linked together
- Bags are open not sealed
- Displacement of existing rocks on the beach would be minimal
- Access to site via King Edward Road due to time of year

<u>Delegation – Helen Forrest – Shoreline Protection Projects</u>

Ms. Forrest was present to discuss concerns relating to shoreline protection works along the beach. Highlights of the presentation included:

- RM should hold public consultations
- Address "illegal" rip-rap placed on Arthur beach
- Decisions should be "knowledge-based"
- Information should be provided to stakeholders on a timely-basis

<u>Delegation – Sally Lawler – Shoreline Protection King Edward / Alexandra</u>

Highlights of the discussion included:

- Opposed to rip-rap structures
- Not opposed to sandbags under certain conditions
- Concerns include experience of contractor doing work / effect of proposed type of bag on beach/ responsibility re: maintenance and associated costs
